

Braille Alphabet

Purpose: To explain how children without a sense of sight are able to read letters and words using their fingertips to locate patterns of raised dots.

Materials:

- Glue*
- A copy of the second page*

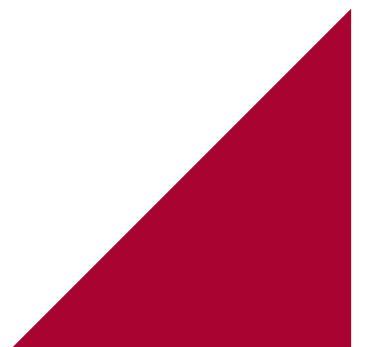
Directions:

- 1. Print out a copy of the second page.*
- 2. Put a drop of white glue over each black dot*
- 3. After the glue is dry you will be able to feel the raised dots with your fingers*
