## Braille Alphabet

Purpose: To explain how children without a sense of sight are able to read letters and words using their fingertips to locate patterns of raised dots.

## **Materials:**

- Glue
- A copy of the second page

## Directions:

- 1. Print out a copy of the second page.
- 2. Put a drop of white glue over each black dot
- 3. After the glue is dry you will be able to feel the raised dots with your fingers

Encourage your children to memorize the letters of the Braille alphabet!



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
